JACK: Switchcraft 12B (Used on car ends and switch boxes in cars) PLUG: Switchcraft 297 (Used on interconnecting cables and amplifier outputs)

Wire color code used:

Red = Tip	(Positive or Hot)
Black = Ring	(Negative or Cold)
Shield (if any) = Sleeve	(Ground)

Note: Some cars have White & Black pair. Then use the following:

White $=$ Tip	(Positive or Hot)
Black = Ring	(Negative or Cold)
Shield (if any) = Sleeve	(Ground)

Note: Some cars have Red & White pair. Then use the following:

Red = Tip	(Positive or Hot)
White $=$ Ring	(Negative or Cold)
Shield (if any) = Sleeve	(Ground)

Back of amplifier color code typically used:

Black $\rightarrow O$ O O O O \rightarrow Red Com 4 Ω 8 Ω 25V 70V

Wire Type and Size: (Shielded or Not) Pair 18AWG (minimum) used for 70v system
